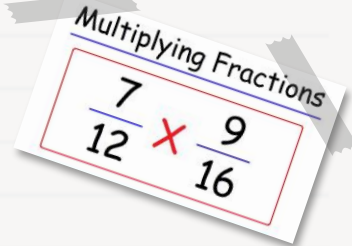


Year 6 Summer Class Plan
